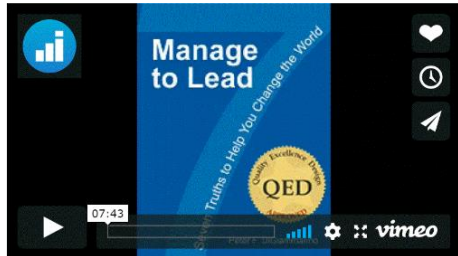

[Strategic Leadership Immersion Program](#) participants learn to describe **their organization's current state, why their organization must change, how their organization will be** once the change has occurred, and what **Strategic Initiatives** must be accomplished to go from the present to the target next state.

For their final project, participants **prepare** and then **deliver a board-level briefing to outside executive reviewers** such as C-level executives, board directors, investors, and advisers.

As an Executive Reviewer, you will:

- Be paired with a participant team who, in the role of the organization's top executive team, will present to you their description, analysis, strategy, and development plan as if you were their board of directors.
- Review a ~5-page slide deck ahead of the session for background and to develop a point of view on the team ahead of meeting.
- **Listen thoughtfully** during the briefing to understand what the executive team has to say, as well as to **ask questions to clarify** and to **push up their thinking**.
- Share your best advice to help the team advance their thinking, understanding, and performance.

You are welcome to share personal stories or insights, but we ask that you be careful **not to spend most of the time listening to your own voice.**
